

FSB's Shirts and Apparel for Participation Program Effective June 1, 2017

This program is designed to increase participation at meetings and chapter activities and to encourage the development of new leaders. Essentially, shirts or other apparel with the FSB logo and members names embroidered are earned by participating in chapter work and activities.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Attending a regular membership meeting:	1 point
Attending a TU board meeting:	1 point
Chapter Sanctioned Volunteer hours (per hour): (See Notes 1&2)	1 point
Recruiting a new member	2 points
Presenting, Instructing, Supervising chapter activities	2 points

In addition, the board has assigned points for the following routine/repeat activities:

• Attending a State Council meeting	4 points
• Prepare Monthly Newsletter	3 points
• Update FSB website each month	3 points
• Preparation of Income Statement and Balance Sheet	3 points
• Fly of the Month Preparation	1 point
• Investment Administration (monthly)	3 points
• Attending a Banquet Committee meeting	1 point
• Preparing coffee for membership and board meetings	1 point

Note 1: *Points for all FSB sanctioned volunteer activities will be limited to 1 point per hour and not to exceed 8 hours/8 points per day. Volunteer activities sanctioned by F&W or non FSB chapters will be limited to one point per two hours and not to exceed 5 points per day.*

Note 2: *Attending fishing trips or Fly Tying courses, do not count as volunteer hours. Instructing a fly tying class or "running a trip" does count toward volunteer hours.*

When a member has accumulated (50) points, he/she will be entitled to apply for a chapter shirt. See Application form attached. Applications are to be submitted to the FSB Vice President who will review and quickly obtain board approval.

If a member accumulates more than (50) points prior to submitting his application (for a shirt or other apparel), "carry-over points will be indicated on the next application. Any member can earn up to two shirts per year.

Baseball style caps with the FSB logo can be obtained when a member has accumulated (25) points.

For members who have received two or more shirts: hoodies, jackets or other apparel can be obtained at one point per dollar of cost. In other words, if the discounted price of the item is \$100.00, the number of points required is 100.

Note that it is the member's responsibility to maintain a list of accumulated points. (honor system) After the board approves the application, the Vice President will order the shirt or other apparel.

Shirts to be awarded will be Simms (and/or of equal value), long sleeve, Guide Shirts. Since color and style offerings change from time to time, we will do our best to satisfy everyone's requests. The FSB logo and the member's name will be embroidered on the shirt or other apparel. The embroiderer has agreed not to embroider the FSB logo for anyone but an authorized FSB representative.

For those members with special requirements (2XL, extra long, etc), the member may purchase the shirt of his or her choosing and be re-imbursed at up to \$53.00 per shirt.

Shirts or other apparel will be purchased from Tightlines in Parsippany where our discount will be 33% for cash purchases. (30 % for credit card purchases)

FSB has paid the set up charge and has a purchase agreement with Monogram Madness in Succussana for \$5.00 per shirt for the embroidery.

The FSB Vice President is responsible for administering this program.
